3. Purpose of Data Processing

The coordination office of the GraCE at the University of Regensburg processes personal data for the administrative management (completion of your doctoral procedure; promotion of early career scientists at the partners of Center for Chiral Electronics (CCE) in particular through advice, information, and invitations to events; Alumni work; Qualitymanagement; Universities statistics; Faculty reports; Archiving; Ensuring the operation of the IT systems on which data is stored and the integrity of the stored data) of the GraCE and for reporting to the German Research Foundation (DFG).

4. Categories of Data Collected

Name, Institutional affiliation, Position/academic status, Contact details (E-Mail, address), Research field /expertise and Membership status (member / associated member).

5. Access to Data

Access to the data is restricted to the coordination office of the GraCE at the University of Regensburg and DFG.

6. Data Storage

Data will be stored securely on systems of the University of Regensburg (e.g., university servers and/or authorized work devices).

7. Duration of Storage

Personal data will be stored for the duration of the funding period of the GraCE and thereafter in accordance with applicable archiving obligations. Insofar as there are no statutory retention obligations for specific personal data, such data will be deleted or anonymized once the purpose has been fulfilled.

8. Legal Basis and Consent

The processing of personal data is based on your consent in accordance with Article 6(1)(a) GDPR.

Members from partner institutions consent to the processing of their data by the coordination office at the University of Regensburg.

9. Transfer to a third country or international organization

There will be no transmission to third countries or international organizations.



10. Rights of the Data Subjects (GDPR)

You are entitled to request from the controller:

- access to (a copy of) and information about the processing of your personal data, according to Art. 15 GDPR,
- rectification of your personal data, according to Art. 16 GDPR,
- erasure of your personal data, according to Art. 17 GDPR,
- restriction of / objection to processing your data, according to Art. 18 & 21 GDPR,
- a copy of your data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format (data portability), according to Art. 20 GDPR.

You can withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the following supervisory authority:
